

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

Thank you for your interest in our product. Please find below the requested information.

REACH: Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC)

Substances of Very High Concern are defined in Article 57 of the REACH Regulation and include substances which are:

- Carcinogenic, Mutagenic or toxic to Reproduction (CMR), meeting the criteria for classification in category 1A or 1B in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008;
- Persistent, Bioaccumulative and Toxic (PBT) or very Persistent and very Bioaccumulative (vPvB) according to the criteria in Annex XIII of the REACH Regulation;
- Identified, on a case-by-case basis, from scientific evidence as causing probable serious effects to human health or the environment of an equivalent level of concern as those above (e.g. endocrine disrupters).

The European Chemicals Agency ECHA maintains a list with Substances of Very High Concern. After a substance is included in this Candidate List there is a legal obligation to provide enough information to allow the safe use along the supply chain if the concentration of the concerned substance is above 0.1% (w/w).

We confirm to our best knowledge that our products do not contain any SVHC, except in very rare cases when there are very low quantities of technically unavoidable impurities (typically coming from the solvents) which however are substantially below 0.1% (w/w).

This statement is based on the Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) as published by the European Agency (ECHA) on January 23, 2024.

Lipoid Kosmetik AG is monitoring the list of SVHC as published by the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) on a regular basis.

This information is to the best of our knowledge and is based on the product's composition as of today.
